## Cal Grant – GPA Submission

Cal grants can be used at any UC, USC, California Community College, almost all independent colleges, and many career and technical schools in California.

Cal Prep Academy will submit all 12<sup>th</sup> grade GPAs to California Student Aid Commission by October 1, 2018.
